- Currency: Hryvnia






HISTORICAL ROUTES

- First human settlement dates back to 4500 BC
- Between 700 BC and 200 BC it was part of the Scythian Kingdom, or Scythia
- ✤ 9th -12th century was a part of Kievan Rus'
- Later was divided into numerous states and by the end of 19th century was integrated into Russian Empire, with the rest under Austro-Hungarian control
- In 1922 Ukraine became a republic of the Soviet Union
- Gained independence on the 24th of August 1991
